

## Program Monitoring and Interventions Glossary

**Campus Intervention Team (CIT):** A team composed of the DCSI and PSP responsible for working with the campus leadership team (CLT) to conduct intervention requirements.

**Campus Leadership Team (CLT):** A team of key campus leaders responsible for the development, implementation, and monitoring of the targeted improvement plan.

**District Leadership Team (DLT):** A team of key district leaders responsible for the development of a broad based intervention team to conduct and monitor activities of the TAIS process. The team may include representatives from staged programs and campuses in improvement.

**District Coordinator of School Improvement (DCSI):** A local district administrator, in a leadership position responsible for student performance, who ensures district support for the academic achievement of the campus and implementation of all intervention requirements.

**Professional Service Provider (PSP):** An experienced educator who provides technical assistance to campuses in building the capacity of campus and district leaders, teachers, and staff to understand the TAIS continuous improvement process. This individual also serves as a liaison between the Texas Center for District and School Support (TCDSS), TEA, local education service center (ESC), and district/charter school.

**Texas Accountability Intervention System (TAIS) Process:** The Texas Accountability Intervention System (TAIS) is designed to establish the foundational systems, actions, and processes to support the continuous improvement of campuses. The TAIS framework for continuous improvement process consists of data analysis, needs assessment, improvement planning, and implementation and monitoring.
