

Wheel of PSP Responsibilities

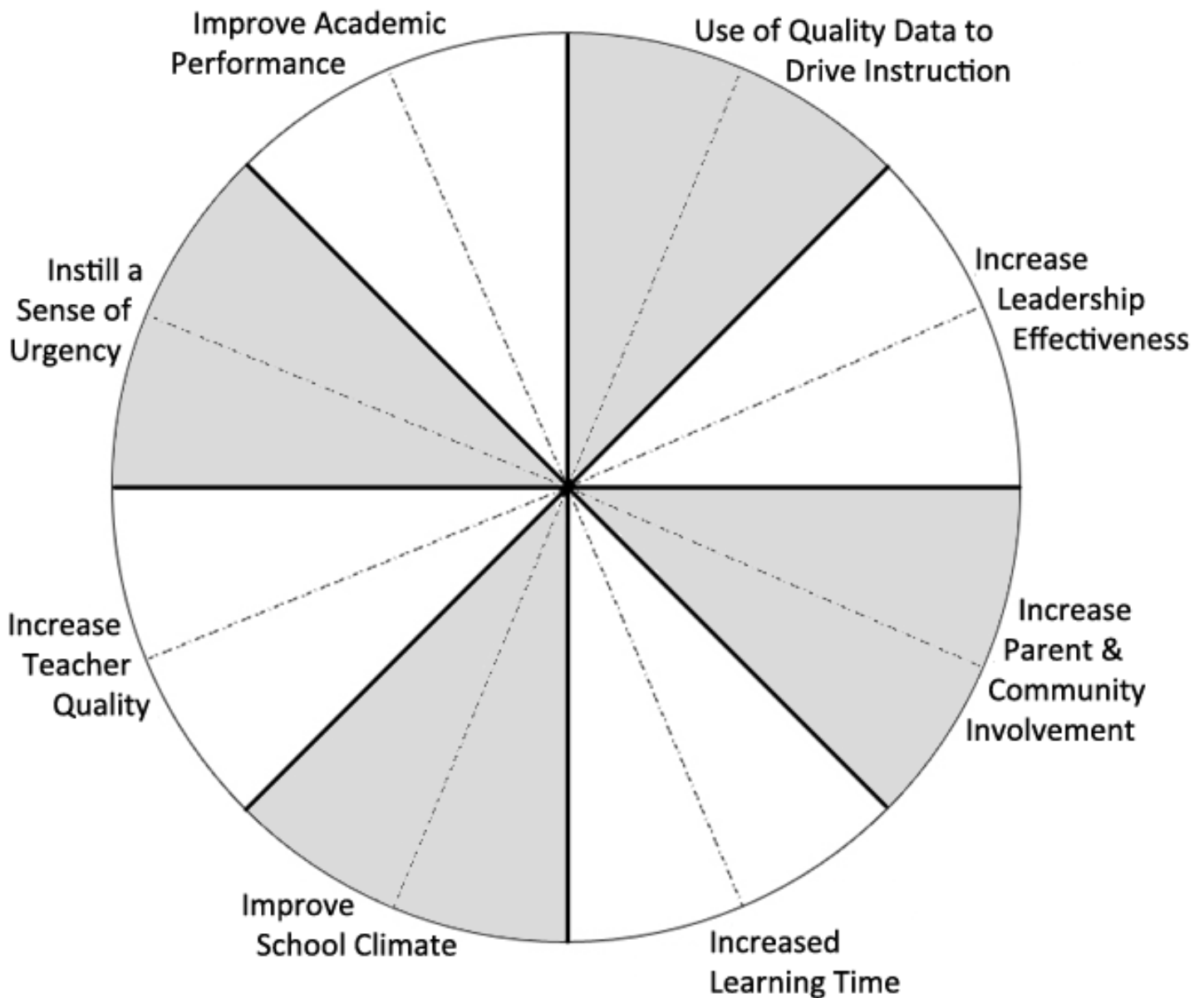

Directions: The 8 sections in the Wheel of PSP Responsibilities represent various competencies related to Critical Success Factors that Professional Service Providers use to focus their campuses on what is needed to help them meet current accountability standards.

A zero (center of the wheel) indicates an area where you feel you need a lot of support. A ten (outer edge of the wheel) shows you are very confident in your expertise and experience.

Place a point on the dotted line in each wedge to indicate your level of expertise today. Draw lines from point to points and create a new outer edge. The new perimeter represents your current level of expertise in the areas your campus(es) must excel in to meet accountability standards. Example of a Completed Wheel of PSP Responsibilities

The following is an example of a completed Wheel of PSP Responsibilities. The blue dots represent the level of expertise for each CSF. The shaded area is an overall picture of this person's skill level. Note where the dot is placed on the dotted line representing *Increase Parent & Community Engagement*. This is an potential area for improvement and one the PSP will seek professional learning opportunities.
